Driver requirements

The renter and drivers must be at least 21 years old. The maximum age is 70 years. A driving license class 3 or equivalent is required for all models. Class B or equivalent for vehicles with a total permissible weight of up to 3,500 kg and class C for more than 3,500 kg total weight. Drivers with driving licenses of classes B and C must have held a driving license for a minimum of 1 year.

Deposit/credit card

Upon collection of the vehicle, the driver needs to present a valid credit card in the driver's name. This will be used for the security deposit of €1,500. The security deposit will be charged immediately. The security deposit is returnable on return in proper condition and after final invoicing by CAMPER CLUB rental station. All extras will be deducted from the security deposit on return of the vehicle. If the renter falls into arrears with his payment obligations, interest on arrears will be charged according to the valid statutory regulations. The renter can provide evidence of lower damages from arrears.

Minimum rental period

Low and middle season: 3 days minimum

High season: 8 days minimum



One-ways

One-way rentals are only possible on request and against a fee

Changes

The reservation confirmed to the renter can be rebooked by the renter up to 30 days before the agreed commencement date of the rental period, provided that other dates are available. For this, an administration fee of €50 per rebooking will be charged. Any cancellation fee is always calculated on the basis of the first confirmed reservation.

Cancellations

The charge of Camperclub Greece is:

50 days or more before pick up	10 % of the total rental costs
Between 49 days and 15 days before pick up	50 % of the total rental costs
Between 14 days and 1 day before pick up	80 % of the total rental costs
Departure day (no show)	100 % rental charges

The charge of Worldwide campers is:

Between booking and 15 days before pick up	50 euro
Between 14 days and day of pick up	100 euro

Transfers

Transfers need to be arranged before picking up the vehicle, please contact Worldwide campers for the charges.

Picking up the vehicle

Pickup time at working days starts at 09:00am & return time is 20:00 at the latest. The pickup and return days are included in the renting period and they are charged.

Dropping off the vehicle

Drop-offs until 10:00 in the morning are free of charge. For drop-offs from 10:00 – 13:00 there is an extra charge for late drop-off. For drop-offs after 13:00 there is full day charge.

Vehicle size

If the reserved vehicle cannot be supplied at the rental station, CamperClub reserves the right to provide a vehicle of similar size and similar equipped, or a larger vehicle. In this case, no additional rental costs are incurred by the customer. If a smaller vehicle is offered and it is accepted by the renter, the price difference between the two vehicles will be refunded. If additional costs arise due to the provision of a larger vehicle, such as ferry and toll charges or running costs, these are paid by the renter.





Breakdown assistance and repair reimbursement

The renter may authorize any repairs necessary to guarantee the operational and road safety of the vehicle up to a value of €50 without prior consultation. Major repairs above this value may only be authorized with the consent of the place of hire. The repair costs will be reimbursed by the place of hire on presentation of the relevant original receipts as well as the replaced parts provided that the renter is not responsible for the damage. Damage claims for faults existing before the contractual agreement was concluded and for which the rental company is not responsible will not be recognized.

Travel restrictions

It is possible to travel abroad with the campervan within Europe. For travel in Eastern European and non-European countries, the prior permission of the lesser must be obtained and special insurance cover must be taken out. Travel in war or disaster zones is prohibited.

Parking/Traffic Violations

The renter is liable for all fees, charges, fines and penalties charged to CamperClub in connection with the use of the vehicle, unless they are caused by the fault of CamperClub

Pets and animals

Pets are only permitted in the vehicles subject to agreement with the hire agency

Smoking

Smoking is not allowed inside the vehicles
