Driver requirements

Minimum age 25 years (No maximum age), valid drivers license for 2 years. All drivers must have been in possession of a Class III / Class B or comparable national driving license for at least two years — for groups Family Luxury and Premium, for not less than 3 years — corresponding to the weight of the vehicle. The driver must be in possession of a valid identity card or passport. Please note that some of the Rental Firm's vehicles have a total weight of more than 3.5 tons and that to drive these vehicles an appropriate driving license is required. Those in possession of a Class B driving license must consult the Rental Firm about the engine size and the technically permissible total weight of the vehicle rented. If, upon renting, a respective driving license cannot be presented, the motorhome shall be regarded as not collected. In such case, there shall apply the respective terms of cancellation. A digital drivers license is not allowed.

International driving licenses in Europe

Please be aware that all drivers need to present one of the following driving licenses at Pick-Up at a rental location in Europe:

- Local driving license (issued in the country of Pick-Up)
- EU driving license (issued in a member state of the EU or the European Economic Area)
- International driving license together with the original local driving license

The original documents need to be presented. A copy is insufficient.





Deposit/credit card

Upon collection of the vehicle, the driver needs to present a valid credit card (not digital) in the driver's name. This will be used for the security deposit. The Rental Firm will reimburse the security deposit after the final rental account has been settled, as long as the vehicle is returned as required. Any charges incurred in addition to the hire charge paid in advance by the Hirer will be deducted from the security deposit when the vehicle is returned.

The motorhome is covered by a statutory motor vehicle third-party liability insurance with an insurance cover (varies by country). The liability for New Zealand is NZD 7.500

The excess is set off against the security deposit. Any damage not covered by the insurance, such as for example damage caused by alcohol- or narcotics-related unfitness to drive, by leaving the vehicle to an unauthorized driver, etc., are completely at the Hirer's expense. Any damage to the interior and/or the inventory is not covered by the insurance either so that respective costs of repair or replacement must be completely borne by the Hirer. The Rental Firm is not liable for any damage, whether direct or indirect, caused by acts of the Hirer.

require the presentation of an international driver's license (for non-EU citizens). It should be noted that some vehicles have a total weight of over 3.5 tonnes and to drive these vehicles it is required to hold an appropriate driving license. Holders of B class driving license must check with the Rental the permissible total weight of the rented vehicle.

Minimum rental period

The minimum rental period is 5 days; different minimum hire periods will vary during peak seasons.

Changes

The Hirer may request free date amendments to a confirmed booking up to 40 days prior to the date of the agreed commencement of the rental period subject to the Rental Company having alternative capacity and booking dates available. The rental rates are based on the current price list valid at the time of the change, unless the hire rate for the alternative dates decreases, in which case the original rental rate will apply. Amendments within 40 days prior to commencement of the rental period are treated as per the below cancellation terms.

Cancellations

Between booking and 40 days before pick up: 30% of the rental costs (min. of NZD 500)

Between 39 days and 7 days before pick up: 50% of the total charges
Between 7 days and no show 100% of the total charges

Worldwide campers also charge cancellation fees

Between booking and 15 days before pick up: 50 euro
Between 14 days and day of pick up: 100 euro





Transfers

McRent does offer transfers in New Zealand, please contact Worldwide campers for more information.

If you book taxi transfers, please always make sure you sent flight details at time of booking.

Picking up /dropping of the vehicle

The motor home is delivered in a clean condition, with a full tank and equipped according to the inventory list submitted and must be returned in the same condition. If that is not the case, the Rental Firm shall be entitled to charge an amount for the cleaning of the interior. If the tank of the vehicle should not have been filled up, we charge the petrol costs as well as cost of work (€25). Any missing or defect items of the inventory list will be invoiced to you. Any possible retention will be set off against the security deposit.

The pick up time is from 12pm till 3pm from Monday till Friday, and Saturday pick up and drop off is between 10am and 1.30pm. Drop off time is from 9 till 11am from Monday to Friday. Saturday is same as pick up times 10am and 1.30pm.

Vehicle Size / Layout

McRent only guarantees a specific group, NOT a specific vehicle. Layouts and sizes may vary. If it is not possible for McRent to provide a vehicle of the booked group at Pick-Up:

- 1.) a vehicle of an equal or higher category is provided
- 2.) a vehicle of a lower category is provided and the price difference is credited
- 3.) a vehicle at a different location is offered. Any extra charges are borne by the customers
- 4.) If 1. 3. is not possible, the Rental Company reserves the right to cancel the rental free of charge

Travel restrictions

Journeys abroad are not permitted.

Parking/Traffic Violations

All costs incurred as a consequence of criminal activities or traffic offences committed by the hirer or a passenger will be collected by the hirer. Any fines imposed are charged to the hirer's account.

Pets and animals

In view of the experience we had in the past, it is not allowed to carry along any pets in the motorhome, unless with the prior approval of the Rental Firm.

Smoking

Smoking is not allowed in our vehicles.
